

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

# Fountain Improvements

- 1. City removed muskrats, monitored water quality, provided technical specifications and approvals, and cut weeds in our storm drainage pond during the spring and summer
- 2. City advisors, technicians and electrician partnered to secure armoured cables from the USA and build custom parts during the summer to meet standards and withstand future pressures
- 3. Fountain technicians and electrician installed electrical cables and a new aeration system, successfully tested the system and met all of the city requirements this fall
- 4. Both fountains and a new aeration system (which introduces more oxygen into the water to control algae) will be fully operational in spring 2019








# Membership Accounts


93% of members accounts are in good standing. 34 members owe about \$18,000. Payment of dues is mandatory. An annual compounding interest rate of 16% is applied to delinquent accounts and in extreme circumstances, non-payment may result in foreclosure proceedings.






#### **Financial Statement**

...Prepared by chartered accountants as a Notice to Reader, reveals revenues were greater than expenses in 2018, similar to 2017. For every \$1.00 of dues collected, \$0.67 was spent on maintenance and improvements in 2018.




# Vision: to be one of the most desirable places to live in the city


